- Donation Amount

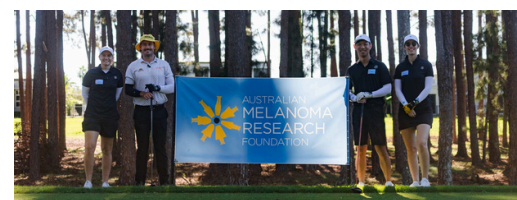
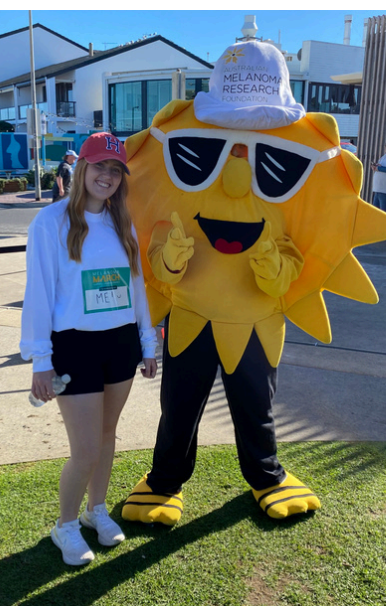
The all important final step of fundraising is **thanking your donors and helpers**. Please let us know of any stand out donors we should send a thank you letter to.



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FUNDRAISING TIPS

- ✓ Ensure you personalise your fundraising page with your story. Why is supporting Australian Melanoma Research important to you? Sharing your story will help others understand why their donation is important.
- ✓ Make the first donation and others will follow your lead.
- ✓ Reach out to your friends, family, colleagues and broader network via personal message first (email, text, etc.), then use social media posts and stories to support this. Your posts and stories can get lost in other people's feeds.
- ✓ Reach out to your employer to see if they can make a donation or have a donation matching program. We can help with any documentation you might require.
- ✓ Thank your donors. A little gratitude goes a long way.
